#### **6 COMMON PROBLEMS FACED BY STUDENTS**

Most of the coachings just provide an overview of UPSC, not consolidation and perfection.

Hence most of the students despite completion of coaching face wide and complex set of problems, such as:-

#### 1. ABSENCE OF REGULAR DEDICATED GUIDE

Many students have capabilities but continuous assistance is required by them from an expert who can guide with commitment for

- · daily enrichment process,
- · regular discussions,
- · problem solving and right guidance,

- making students job fit (UPSC fit)
